And now as we venture into our seventh year we are getting so much recognition of what we do from The Health Service Providers that referrals are coming in at a rate of knots!!

Since the beginning of 2016, as I write this newsletter, we have received 176 referrals. When we started in 2010 we received 9, to 255 in 2015, so we anticipate it being at least 100% up on that figure this year. Rita has £15,000 committed already for client-patients in various stages of treatments, that's over 200 client-patients receiving therapies.
